Platinum Jubilee

As we move into May we are getting all red, white and blue and ready to celebrate the platinum jubilee.

Events we have planned:

On **Thursday May 26th** we will be holding on a playground party from 1.00pm to 3.00pm for all the children. This marks the last day of our half term as **Friday May 27th is our Queen's Jubilee Bank Holiday.**

Children are invited to wear red, white and blue for the day too if they would like. This can be a simple ribbon in their hair or a Union Jack badge or something more, the children can choose.

Each child who normally has a school lunch will get a party picnic box and don't worry everyone will get a special box to put their lunch in so no one will miss out. If for that day your child would like a school lunch, we will be sorting that at the start of the jubilee week so look out for details.

After lunch the children will take part in the planting of a commemorative tree and plaque kindly sponsored by Oxley's of Nantwich and then playing a carousel of 1950s children's games.

In addition, the Governors have kindly sponsored a competition to design a cake for the Queen to mark her Jubilee. Don't worry they don't have to make it, just design it. Entry forms are in bags and attached to this Newtletter. Thank-you to our Governors for sponsoring some super prizes and for being judges alongside Mr Mannion.

Funds

To add some extra fun to our party we want to purchase some resources, decorations and extra food treats for all. On Thursday 5th and Friday 6th May we will have some Jubilee Party collection buckets out at the front of school in the hope of helping raise some much needed pennies towards the event. We would ask for a minimum £1 donation per child.

Finally, the Nantwich Educational Partnership (NEP) are working together with Nantwich museum to produce a walking timeline through Pillory Street and around to Hospital street to commemorate the decades of the Queen's reign.

The children's artwork will be on show in business windows from Monday May 23rd to June 10th. We will aim to take some classes down into town if the weather stays fine in the week before half term to walk the trail.

Staff do not have to give medicines but we always try to help parents to make it easier for you but please be realistic about how much you are

asking. If an exact time is needed or it is absolutely imperative not to miss a dose it may be worth considering if it is better, you come into school to give it. If you can get medication that lasts all day better still.
