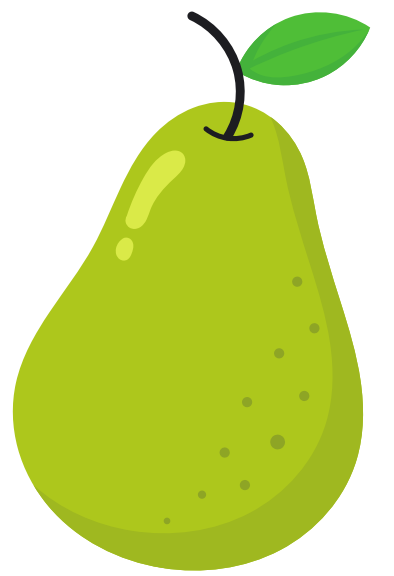




# Pear Tree Primary School

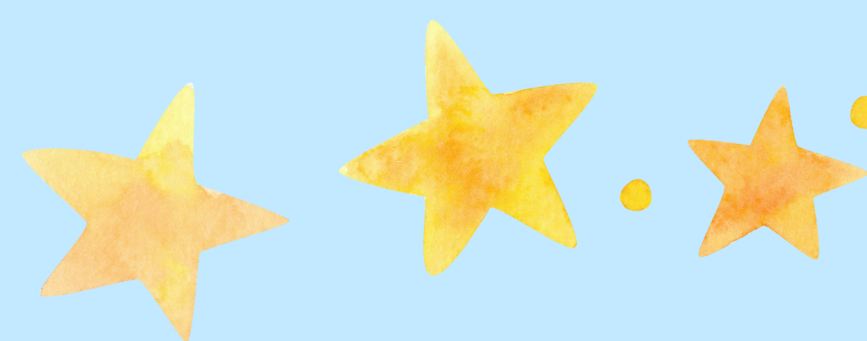
## Your PTA Needs You!

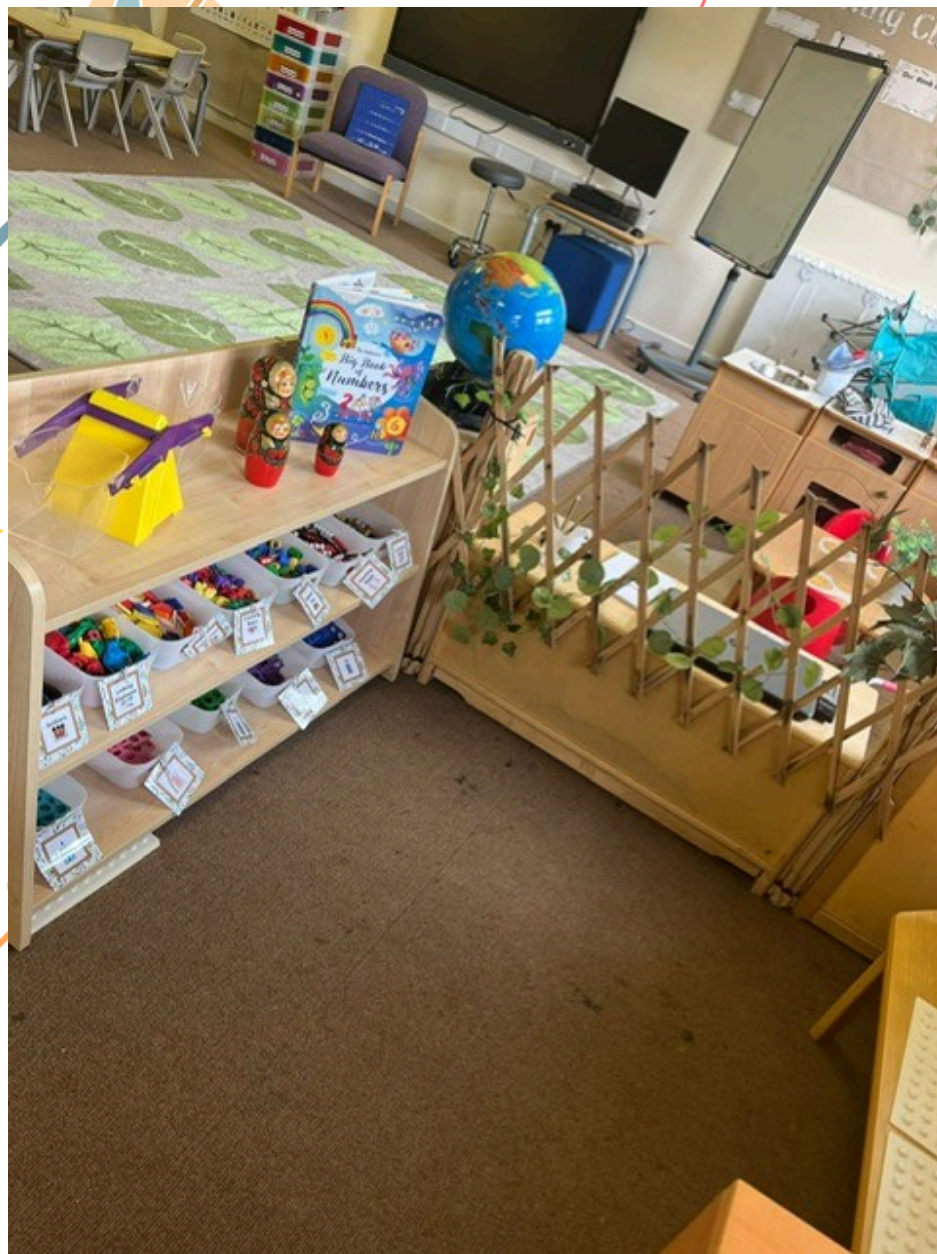




# Early Years

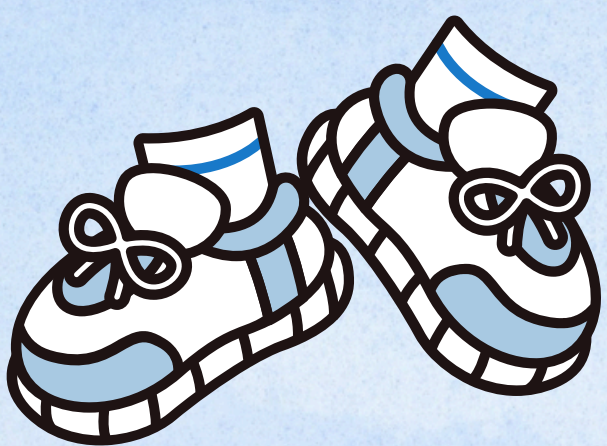
