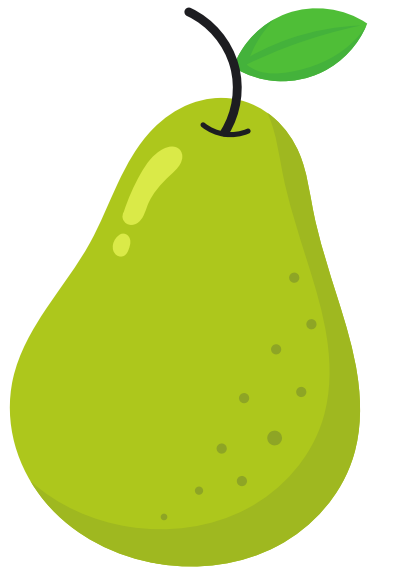




# Pear Tree Primary School

## Your PTA Needs You!

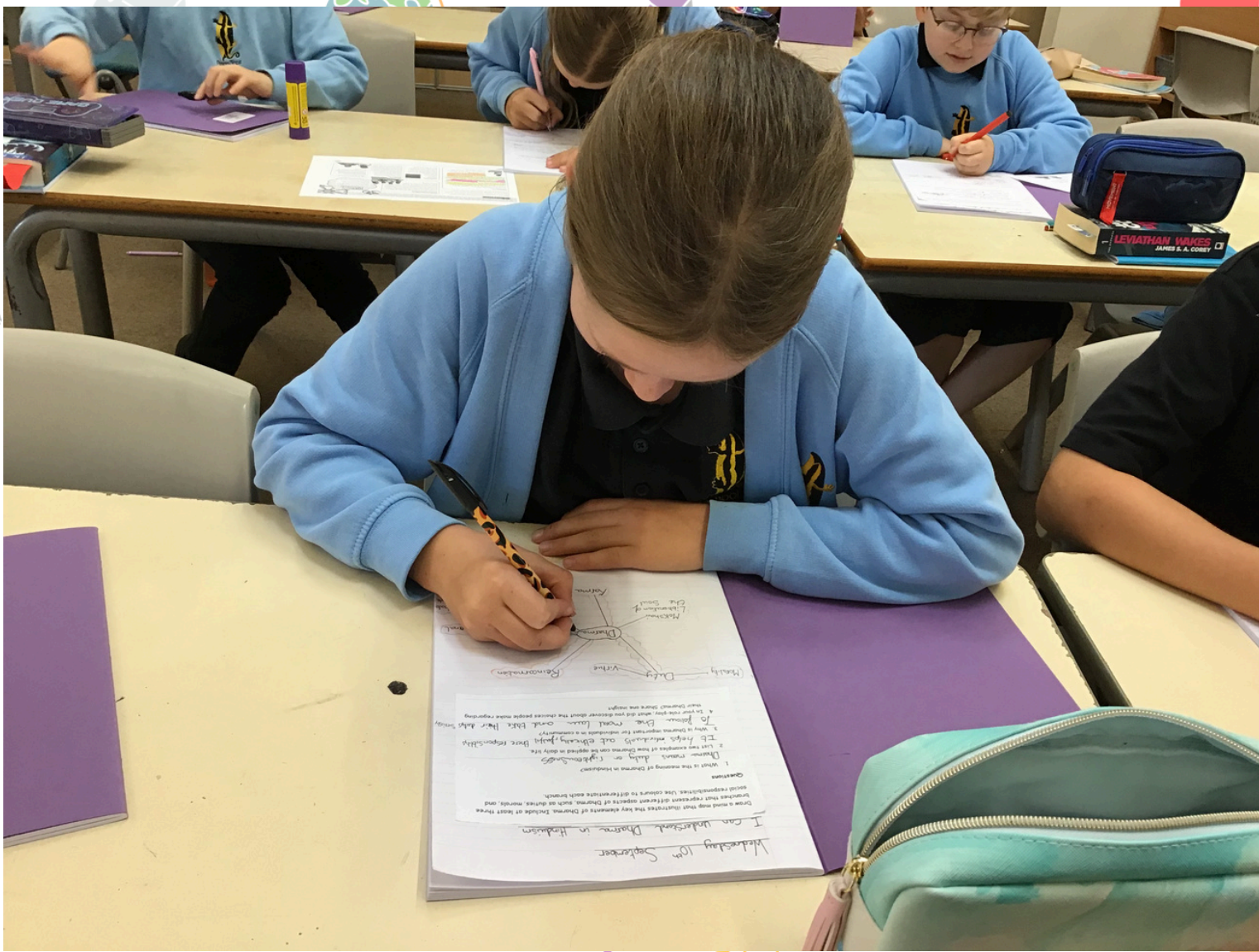

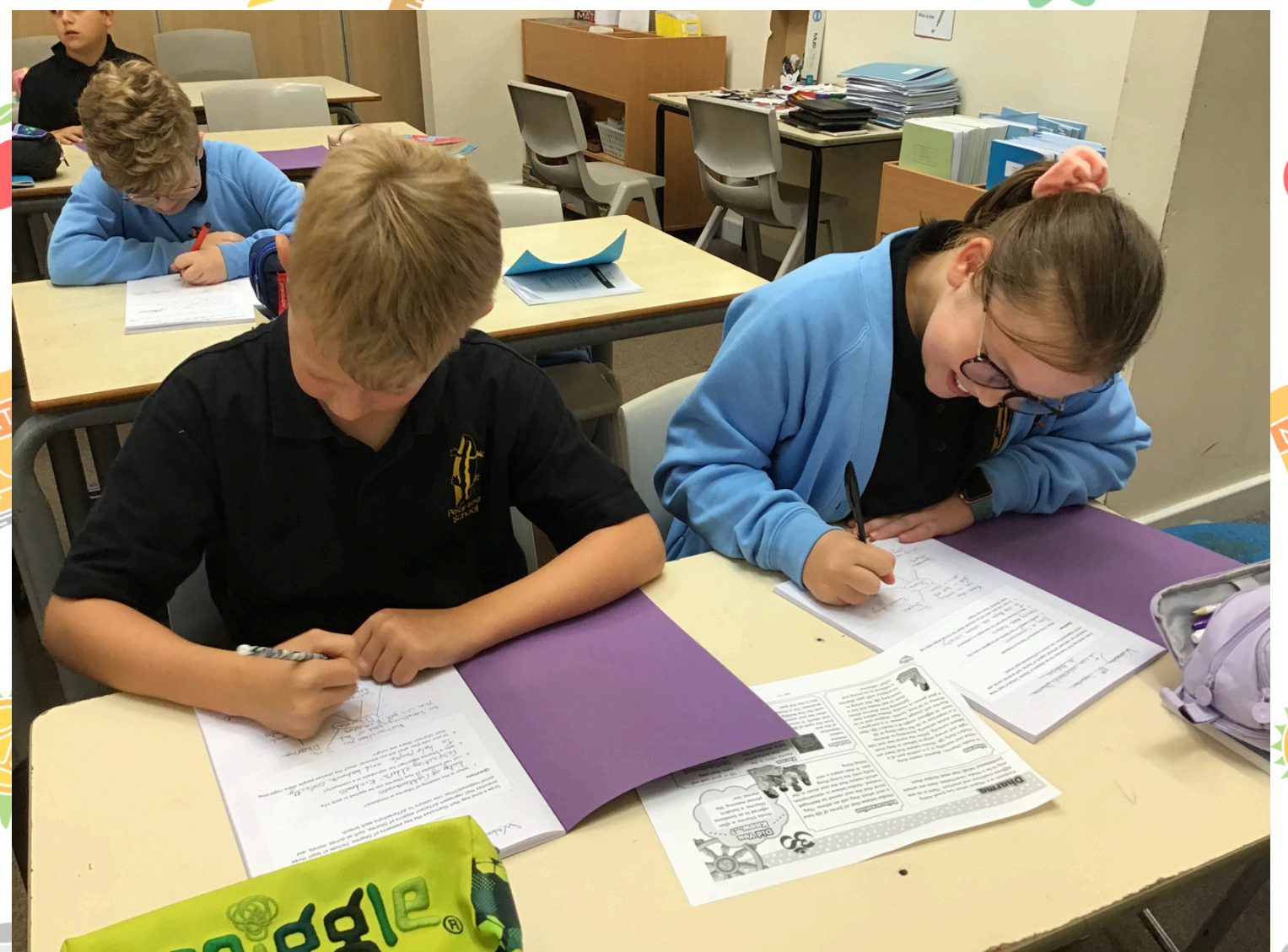


# VIOLET CLASS

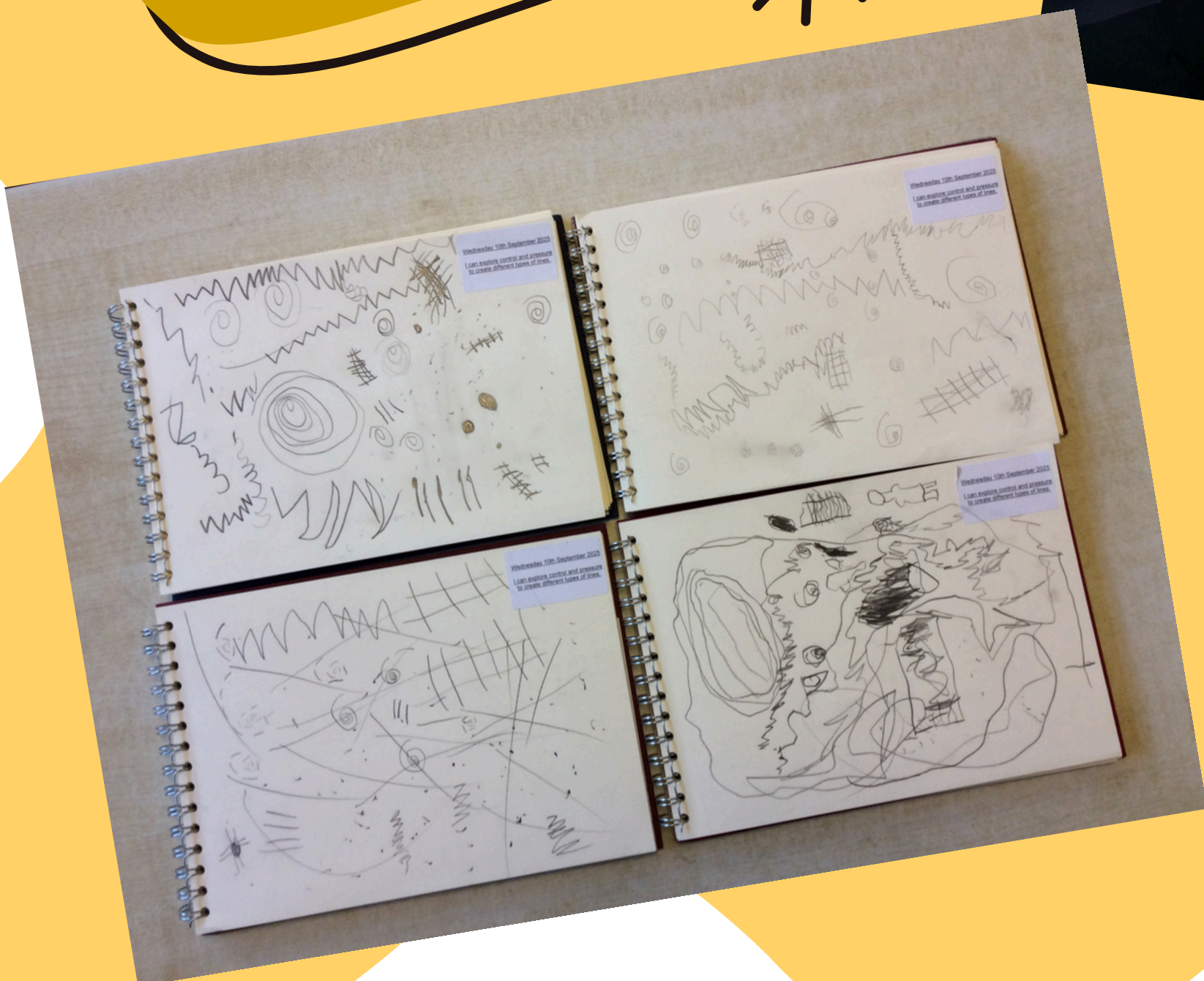


# Masterpieces in the making!

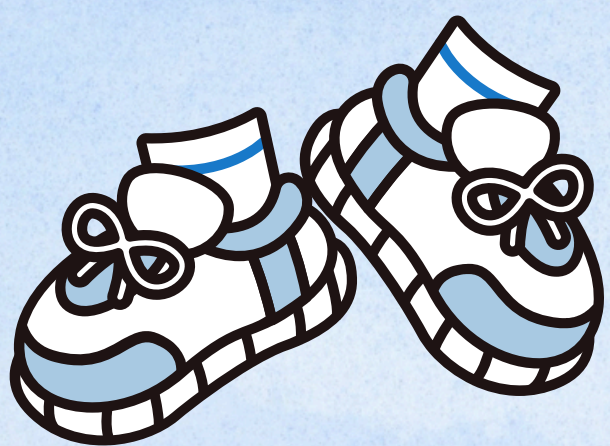

## ***HARVEST FESTIVAL***

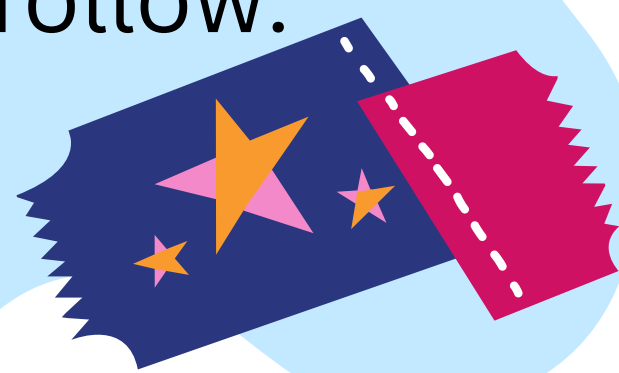
We are pleased to be supporting Nantwich Food Bank for Harvest Festival, this year.
